

Hit 20

You will need

- six 1 → 6 spot dice
- pencil and paper for jottings

Each player takes a turn to roll six dice.

The object of the game is to use all the numbers rolled.

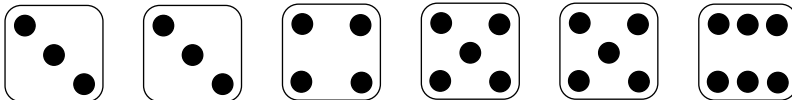
Using addition and subtraction, the player tries to get to 20 or the nearest to 20 to win the round.

Play 5 rounds.

The player who wins the most rounds is the winner.

Hit 20

Player 1 rolls...



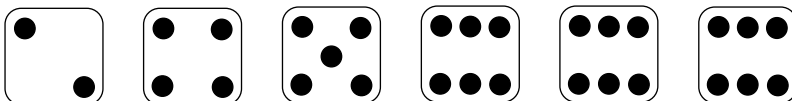
If I just add them together, I'll get a total of 26. I need to make my answer smaller.

If I add 4 and 6 together, I'll get 10. If I add 5 and 5 together that makes another 10, so 20 in total. I have two 3s left. I will add three to 20 to make 23, then subtract 3 to make 20.

My answer is 20.

Hit 20

Player 2 rolls...



If I add all my dice together, I'll get a score of 29. My score is too big. I'm going to have to do some subtracting.

$6 + 6 + 6 = 18$, $18 - 4 = 14$, $14 + 2 = 16$, $16 + 5 = 21$

$6 + 6 + 6 = 18$, $18 - 5 = 13$, $13 + 2 = 15$, $15 + 4 = 19$

My answer is 19.

Hit 20

Variation

- Use fewer dice (5 dice or 4 dice) and addition only
- Use different dice, such as six 4, 8 10 and 12 sided dice.
- Use all four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division)
- Use decimal dice, all four operations and a target of 2.
