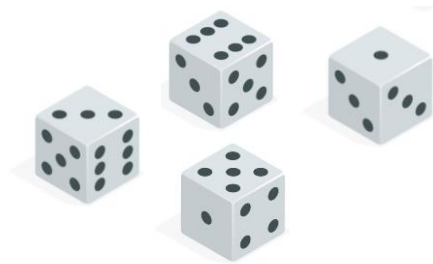


Climb to the top

You will need

- four 1 → 6 spot dice
- an addition pyramid each (see next page)
- pencil and paper for jottings



Players take turns to roll four dice.

The numbers rolled are then written into the bottom four bricks of the pyramid.

Player 1 then adds the bricks together to get a final score (the top brick).

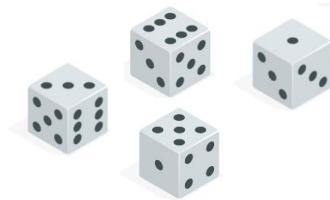
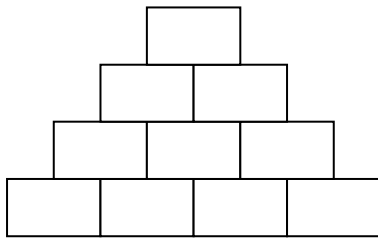
The player with the largest total wins that round.

The winner is the player with the most wins out of 5 rounds.

Climb to the top

The pyramid can be printed out or drawn on a piece of paper.

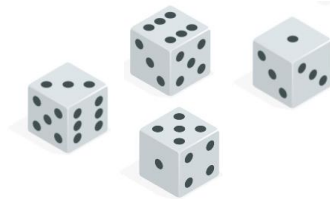
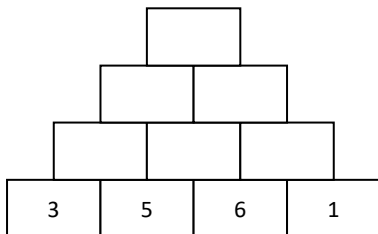
The cells need to be large enough to comfortably write numbers inside.



Climb to the top

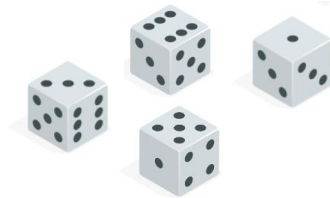
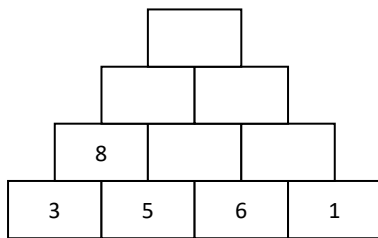
Player 1 has rolled 1, 3, 5 and 6.

The write these numbers into the bottom four bricks.



Climb to the top

Add two bricks together and write the total into the brick above.



Climb to the top

Repeat this until you have total in the very top brick. This will be Player 1s score for that round.

Player 1 then compare their score with Player 2. The largest score wins.
