

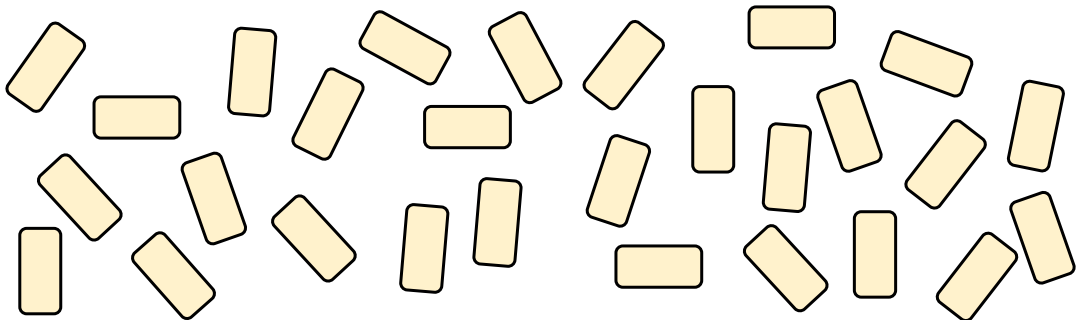
# Domino addition

## Domino addition

A game for two players and a full set of dominoes.



There are 28 dominoes in a complete 1 → 6 spot set.

Place the dominoes face down on the table and shuffle them around.

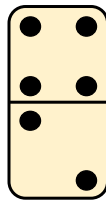
# Domino addition

Each player takes turns to turn over two dominoes from the table.

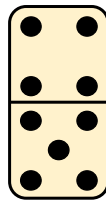
Player 1

Turns over two dominoes and works out the total of each piece.

This domino is worth 6



This domino is worth 9



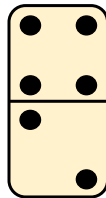
# Domino addition

Player 1

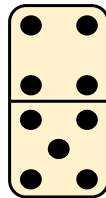
Adds the two dominoes together.

The sum of 6 and 9 is 15.

This domino is worth 6



This domino is worth 9



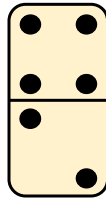
Score

## Domino addition

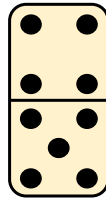
The sum of both dominoes becomes the score for that round.

Player 1 keeps their dominoes.

This domino is worth 6



This domino is worth 9



Score

Player 2 takes two dominoes from the middle of the table.

## Domino addition

The game ends after five rounds.

The player with the highest score wins the game.

Vary this game by using...

- different set of dominoes; for example, 9 and 12 spot dominoes
- increasing the number of rounds
