



Dice totals

You will need :

- two dice 1 – 6 spot
- a recording sheet and pencil

Each player takes a turn to roll the two 1 – 6 spot dice.

Write the numbers from the dice in the dice column

Multiply the two numbers together and write the total in the score column.

Put the total into the total column (this will be the same as the score when you roll the dice for the first time).

Take turns rolling the dice and completing the table, keeping a running total in the right hand column.

Dice totals

Here is an example of a player's game card.

Dice	Score	Total
2 5	10	10
3 6	18	28
4 2	8	36

The winner is the first one to reach or pass the total of 50

Dice totals

Variations

- Change the total to reach, e.g. 80, 100, etc.
- Use 8 sided dice
- Use 10 sided dice
- Use 12 sided dice
- Use Roman Numeral dice
- Use blank dice and select your own numbers (include negative numbers)
- Use one whole number dice and one fraction dice
- Use one whole number dice and one decimal dice
- Use fraction dice
- Use decimal dice
