Odd and even

This is a game for two players and two dice.

- Players take it in turns to roll both dice.
- The two dice are added together.
- If the total of both dice is odd, then the player doubles the total. This becomes their score for the round.
- If the total of both dice is even, then the player halves the total. This becomes their score for the round.
- The dice are rolled again.
- After 10 rounds, the player with the highest total wins.
